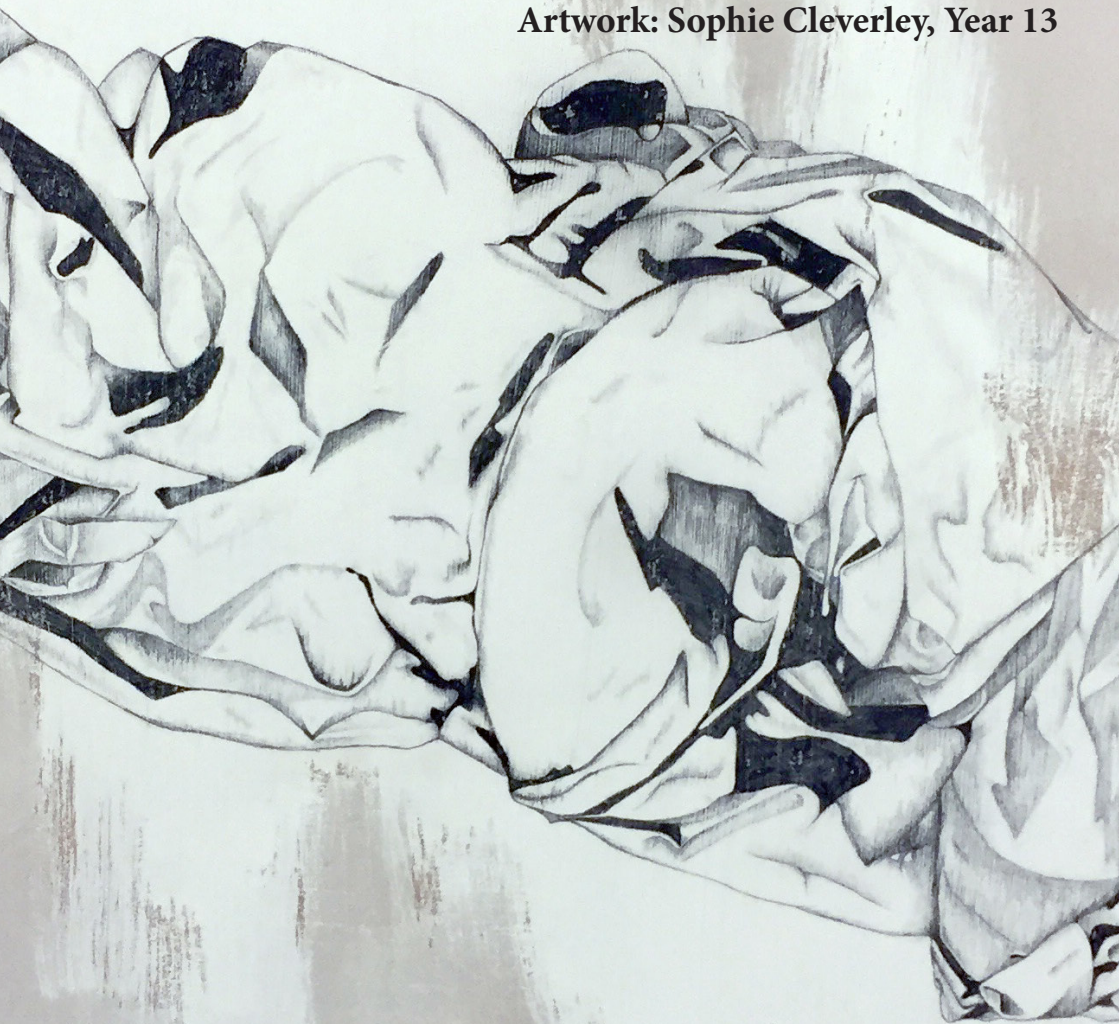


# CREATIVE ARTS AWARDS EVENING 2018

## Creative Arts Badge

The Creative Arts badge is awarded to students who show excellence and effort within lessons, or within the school.

It is usual for students to have been awarded their badge before they then apply for a tie, although there are exceptional circumstances.

We are looking for enthusiasm for the subject, and ambitious class and homework, and a desire to get involved, whether it is brilliant group work in drama, attending art club, being part of the orchestra or making your own films or lots of other activities as well.

## Creative Arts Tie

The Creative Arts tie is awarded to students who go above and beyond within the school, and demonstrate the same enthusiasm and approach to their creativity and initiative outside of school.

They are asked to complete a Creative Arts Tie application providing sufficient evidence:

- To provide visual evidence of work in exhibitions, events organised, groups, workshops attended, etc.
- To bring in visual evidence of work completed out of school.
- To provide a letter by the course or group leader, event organiser with dates attended.
- To write a brief description of how criteria have been fulfilled.
